



*If you wish to make a donation to a charity, there are potential benefits to contributing as a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD). A QCD is any distribution from a Traditional (or Roth) IRA made directly by the IRA trustee to a qualified charitable organization when the IRA owner is age 70-1/2 or older. This method may be able to provide tax benefits whether or not you itemize your deductions. In addition, a QCD can satisfy all or a portion of your required minimum distribution (RMD) and up to \$100,000 of QCDs may be excluded annually from an individual's taxable income. Consult your Financial Advisor or tax professional to ensure a QCD is in your best interest and that your distribution qualifies.
